Retail - Annual General Service Single Phase - Lease Town

AVAILABILITY

Available to customers of the District in towns that have a current O&M lease agreement with Northeast. Service under this schedule is for non-seasonal and non-residential loads, including but not limited to commercial establishments, separate garages and out-buildings only and other loads which are not classified for service under other rate schedules. Available to customers using less than 500 kWh per year.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase, 60 cycle, at available voltages.

RATE:

ANNUAL MINIMUM CHARGES

The annual minimum charge under the above rate shall be \$382.20 where 25 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity, the annual minimum charge shall be increased at the rate of \$12.00 for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. Payment of the annual minimum charge will be made annually in advance of receiving service. No kWh's are allowed for the annual minimum charge.

ENERGY CHARGES

All kWh's will be billed a 4.828¢ generation charge.
All kWh's will be billed a .901¢ transmission charge.
All kWh's will be billed a 2.225¢ distribution charge.

The total charge is 7.954¢ per kWh.

The meter shall be read at the end of each twelve-month period and at any other time appropriate to the District for monitoring purposes. Customers with AMR meters and that use over 500 kWh per year will be moved to one of the monthly single phase Service Rates and will be billed monthly.

ANNUAL BILLING FOR SERVICES

At the completion of each twelve-month period, or when disconnected at the request of the customer, the customer will be billed for energy charges for all kWh's used during the previous twelve-month period and for the annual minimum charges for the succeeding twelve-month period.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Penalty dates are posted on monthly bills. The District's policies governing penalties collection charges, and disconnection of service for non-payment shall apply.
