**AVAILABILITY**

Service under this schedule is restricted to residential service only. Service is subject to the District's established rules and regulations. Non-residential loads connected through the same meter may disqualify the residence from being served on this rate. The District's management will review cases of multiple uses on one meter and make a determination about the best rate classification.

**TYPE OF SERVICE**

Single-phase, 60 cycle, at available voltages.

**SUMMER** - for energy (kWh's) used during the months of June-July-August-September

**MINIMUM CHARGES**

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be the Customer Charge of \$0.82 a day where 25 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity, can't be on the Residential PrePay Rate at this time. A monthly true up billing will be generated, but no statement is mailed out. **ANNUAL CHARGES FOR SEASONAL SERVICES**

Customers requiring service less than 500 kwh per year may request service according to Annual Single Phase with an annual minimum charge is due and payable in advance under the Annual Single Phase Rate. Any service disconnected and reconnected at the customer's request within a twelve month period by the customer will be charged a disconnect or reconnect fee for each trip to render service. The district stand-by service rider applies to this rate.
